Those Precious Little Children

Cornerstones Dear Ones Child Care Program has been serving the children of our homeless guests and other community partners for five years. Many children have found the comfort and consistency of being cared for in a safe environment. One of our favorite stories is about a little boy that ran up and hugged the knees of a volunteer who had been coming several times a week for several weeks in a row. He exclaimed with a big smile "You came back!" The funny thing is he had done the very same thing every time she entered the child care center. These children have experienced so many changes in their short lives, many people coming and going, many moves, and



not much that stayed the same. Their parents' adversity affects them no matter how young they are. Growing up safe and secure is something every child deserves, but it does not always happen that way. Going to bed hungry, not having a bed to go to, or being frightened and unsure is not what we like to think about for a child, but it happens every day in our nation and right here in our own community.

We see the children at Dear Ones excelling, the parents are able to keep appointments, attend treatment programs, job development programs, look for employment and permanent housing. They are all beginning to experience the hope of new lives and a new beginning. These children are teaching us about love, hope and feeling needed.

Please consider volunteering at the Dear Ones Child Care Program the next time the sound of the laughter of a little child fills the air.

"We walk by faith, not by sight." The Apostle Paul's words in 2 Corinthians have so easily become cliché in modern times. A catchphrase for times of difficult decisions, a throwaway line to push past things we don't understand. But what does it mean to walk by faith and not by sight. Our faith is informed by scripture and prayer, building in us a preconditioned response to the world around us. What we see before us is often a fragment of the bigger picture. Walking by faith is to respond in the light of the Gospel, giving testimony for the hope that is in us through our daily words and actions.

It is not difficult to address the poor and downtrodden from sight alone. A job might help, housing would be beneficial, but at the end of the day what they also need is a relationship with Jesus Christ. Sight may tell us that this is not a problem we are meant to deal with, however Faith tells us that Christians are to be Christ's witnesses, making disciples of all nations.
